Present Simple

We use the **present simple** to describe habits and repeated activities or facts.

Time expressions:

every day / week / month / year,
always, usually, often, etc.

VS

Present Continuous

We use the **present continuous** to describe actions or events that are happening or developing at the time of speaking.

Time expressions:

now, at the moment, at the present, Look!, Listen!, etc.

school. Right now, he is doing exercises.*
