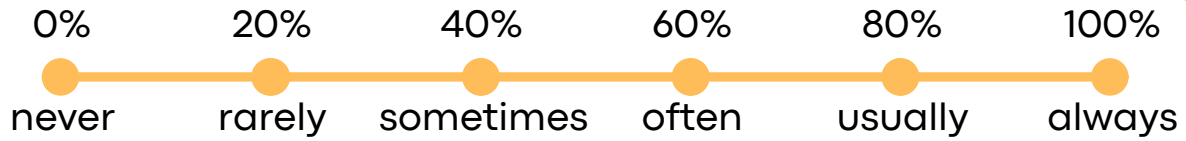


Present Simple

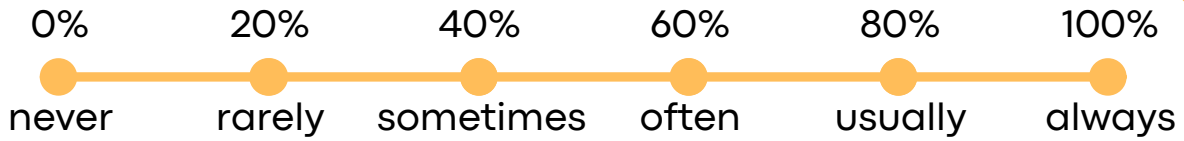
